The MSL plays a crucial role in ensuring that eye care providers have accurate and up-to-date information about our products and therapeutic area. MSLs will report to the National MSL Director.

Key Responsibilities of the Role:

- Develop and maintain relationships with KOLs, academic institutions, and healthcare organizations acting as liaison between LENZ and the eye care community.
- Serve as a scientific expert on our product and therapeutic area, providing medical and scientific information to eyecare providers through interactions, presentations, conferences, etc.
- Identify and collect impactful and actionable insights for internal stakeholders.
- Respond to unsolicited inquiries from healthcare professionals regarding our products, clinical trials, therapeutic area, and medical literature.
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams, including Clinical Development, Regulatory Affairs, and Commercial to support product development and launch activities.
